DON'T LET MEDIA MOGULS DESTROY OUR COUNTRY!

Help us regain independence in radio, newspaper and TV and preserve the right to a "free press" guaranteed in the Constitution!

Tell your Representative to overturn the FCC's rollback of media ownership rules!
On June 2nd, the FCC voted to make sweeping changes in the rules governing who owns the media in this country. As a result:

- Mergers between TV stations will be allowed in over 160 media markets representing 90% of the American viewing public.
- TV/newspaper mergers will be allowed in over 190 media markets representing 98% of Americans.
- These mergers will be allowed without any possibility for challenge - the FCC must automatically approve them all.

What could happen next? The FCC's decision will allow almost **two-thirds** of the markets in the country to have only four local news sources, and a **single** dominant newspaper/TV conglomerate could control well over **half the news audience** and **two-thirds of the reporters** in any given market.

Help protect your right to a diverse and open media. Tell your Senators and Representative to overturn the FCC's debacle. Urge them to support H.R. 2052.
